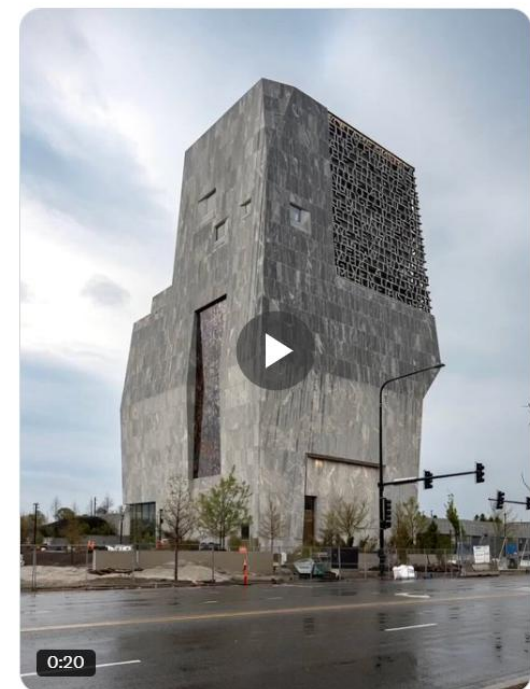

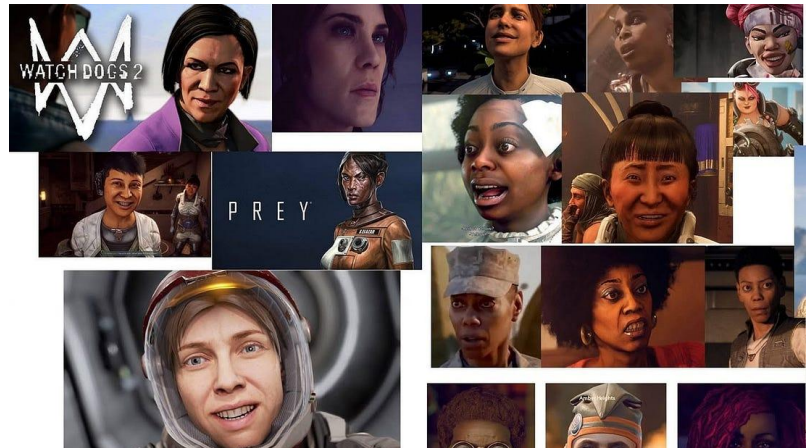

Well, there are a lot of theories around that.

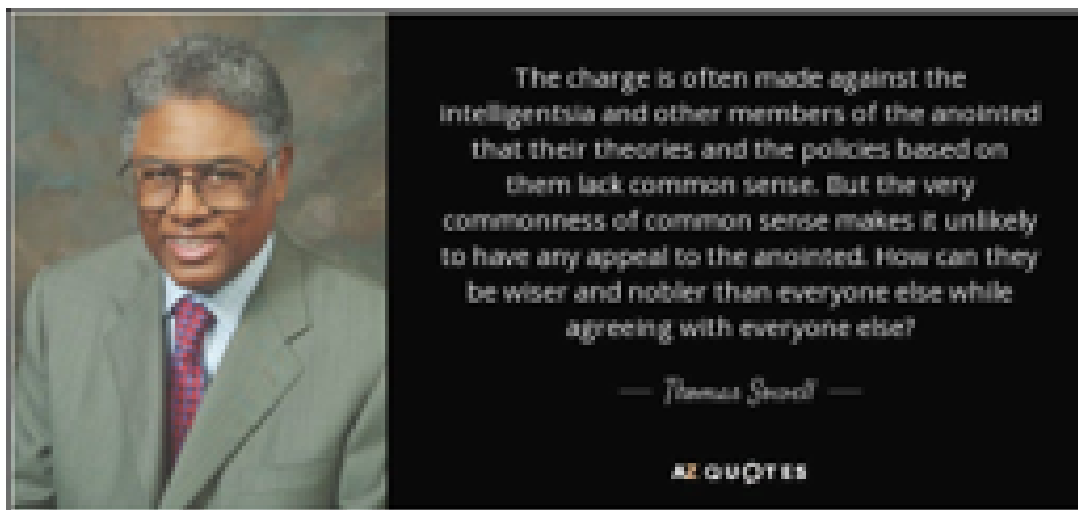
