

Sharpton Drops Truth Bomb For Once: Campus Protests Are Equivalent to Jan. 6 Riots

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On MSNBC, host Reverend Al Sharpton argued that the chaos seen on college campuses by left-wing agitators is hurting Democrats politically. Sharpton pointed out the hypocrisy of condemning the Capitol riots on January 6th, but turning a blind eye to similar riots on college campuses. Co-host Mika Brzezinski initially tried to dismiss the comparison, but Sharpton and fellow co-host Joe Scarborough agreed that actions on college campuses are damaging the Democrats' moral high ground.

Brzezinski and Scarborough watched footage of pro-Palestinian, anti-Semitic protests at the University of California, Los Angeles. Brzezinski expressed shock and horror at the images, finally admitting that they do resemble the chaos seen at the Capitol. Sharpton agreed and reiterated that this type of behavior only serves to hurt the Democrats' stance against the January 6th riots.

Sharpton stated that the campus protesters have lost sight of their message. He accused them of focusing more on inciting violence and making incendiary statements rather than highlighting the situation in Gaza and Israel. He also suggested that outside activists may have infiltrated the group and are pushing their own agendas.

Scarborough added that the [protesters](#) are a mix of people with various intentions, but pointed out that there are undoubtedly some who harbor deep-seated anti-Semitic beliefs. He noted that these individuals are only participating in the protests because Jews are involved.

Former President Donald Trump also weighed in on the situation, commending the police departments in New York and Los Angeles for their intervention in ending campus occupations at Columbia University and UCLA. He labeled the protesters as "radical left lunatics" and emphasized the importance of stopping them before the situation escalates even further.

After several days of not addressing the issue, President Joe Biden finally spoke out against the violence on college campuses. He stated that while there is a right to protest, there is no excuse for destructive and illegal behavior. He also emphasized that such actions only serve to hurt the cause and disrupt the lives of innocent individuals.

Last week, Biden had made a [statement](#) condemning "anti-Semitic protests," but also attempted to justify the actions of those who "don't know what's going on with the Palestinians."

The White House had released a similar statement the day before. But with the realization that this behavior is hurting the Democrats' chances in the upcoming elections, both Biden and MSNBC personalities like Sharpton and Brzezinski are finally willing to acknowledge that these protests are not just expressions of free speech, but disruptive and dangerous displays of campus chaos.
