

Radical Socialist Party Makes Extremist Demands for Newly-Elected Mamdani

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America's greatest cities are falling one by one to a coordinated socialist assault, and what's happening behind closed doors would shock even the most cynical conservative observers (and trust me, we've seen plenty). While voters across the nation cast their ballots this Tuesday believing they were participating in democracy, revolutionary activists were already plotting to transform one of capitalism's most important strongholds into a laboratory for their militant agenda.

The transformation of New York City—the beating heart of global finance and free enterprise—into a socialist experiment represents more than just another local election. Internal documents obtained from socialist organizers reveal a chilling blueprint for dismantling not just capitalism, but America's most fundamental alliances and values.

The "agenda" for the Sunday meeting included a plan to "review policy/demands document draft" and to "assign researcher/writer to each policy peace."

The apparent anti-Israel demands for a Mamdani administration from the DSA working group included:

- “Divest City pension funds from Israeli bonds and securities,”
- “Withdraw City funds from banks that lend money to Israel or do business in Israel,”
- “End City contracts with companies that do business with Israel,”
- “Operate City-run grocery stores free from Israeli products,”
- “Investigate real estate agents hosting illegal sales of stolen lands in the West Bank,”
- “Evict weapons manufacturers and transporters from the NYC Metro Area,”
- “Divest CUNY endowment and reinstate wrongly fired professors,”
- “Dismantle Eric Adam’s NYC-Israel economic council,”
- “End repression of demonstrators and the SRG [the NYPD’s Strategic Response Group],”
- “Remove non-profit status from charities that raise funds for IDF,” “End NYPD training with IOF,” and
- “Arrest Netanyahu and active IDF soldiers for war crimes.”

These aren’t the midnight rants of some basement-dwelling blogger. These are the documented demands of the Democratic Socialists of America, the organization that just helped deliver New York City’s mayoralty to their “comrade” Zohran Mamdani, a self-described democratic socialist who defeated both former Governor Andrew Cuomo and Republican Curtis Sliwa on Tuesday.

The NYC-DSA’s Anti-War Working Group has been meeting in secret for months, crafting what they call their “Palestine Policy” agenda for the incoming Mamdani administration. Their strategy documents—oops, somebody hit ‘share’ by accident—expose plans to “pressure him to staff with people whose values are aligned” and to “leverage Zohran campaign/canvassing infrastructure” to implement their extremist vision.

Radical Demands Surface

The socialist demands read like a declaration of economic warfare against America’s closest Middle East ally. They want to weaponize every financial tool at the city’s disposal—from pension funds to banking relationships to city contracts—to punish Israel. They even demand the creation of “City-run grocery stores free from Israeli products.”

Most alarmingly, they want New York City to “arrest Netanyahu and active IDF soldiers for war crimes,” essentially declaring the city a hostile territory to representatives of a democratic ally. The document even uses the derogatory term “IOF” (Israeli Occupation Forces) instead of IDF, revealing the depth of their anti-Israel animus. Let’s be clear: this isn’t foreign policy. It’s hijacking America’s greatest city as a weapon against our allies.

Communist Roots Run Deep

Mamdani’s socialist credentials run deeper than mere DSA membership. In 2021, speaking at a Young Democratic Socialists conference, he explicitly endorsed “the end goal of seizing the means of production”—the core tenet of Marxist revolution. (Because that worked out so well for Venezuela, right?) He’s repeatedly praised Communist figures like Fred Hampton and celebrated the 1917 Russian Revolution that ushered in Soviet tyranny.

The international socialist network is fully mobilized behind this takeover. Jeremy Corbyn, expelled from UK Labour Party leadership over anti-Semitism allegations, personally hosted phone banks to get Mamdani elected. The DSA’s own tweets celebrate their power “as workers to control the means of production and outnumber the capitalist class.” Make no mistake—this isn’t reform. It’s revolution, delivered with a ballot instead of a bullet.

The Mask Slips Off

During the campaign, Mamdani tried to distance himself from the DSA’s most extreme positions, claiming his platform differed from the national organization. The NYC-DSA even provided him public cover, with their leadership insisting that “Zohran’s administration is not the same as NYC-DSA.” (Sure, and I’ve got a bridge in Brooklyn to sell you.)

But their internal documents tell a different story. The socialist strategy explicitly states they must “grow the size of our movement across every borough” to serve as an “effective outside ally to a potential Zohran Mamdani administration.” They’re not just supporters—they’re handlers, ready to ensure their newly elected mayor implements their revolutionary agenda whether he wants to or not.

What’s happening in New York City isn’t just local politics—it’s a test case for socialist transformation of America. If they can turn capitalism’s global capital into a socialist stronghold that wages economic war on our allies, no American city is safe. The question isn’t whether socialism can happen here. It’s whether Americans will wake up in time to stop it from spreading beyond the borders of what was once the Empire State.
