

Democratic leaders line up behind El-Sayed

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That the leaders of the Democratic Party are falling all over themselves to endorse Michigan Democratic Senate candidate Abdul El-Sayed should tell you everything you need to know about the party's fall.

A member of the Democratic Socialists of America, Mr. El-Sayed supports Medicare for all (which would bankrupt the system and lead to socialized medicine), 100% renewable energy by 2030, abolishing Immigration and Customs Enforcement and an arms embargo on Israel.
